- Would like to know why they was awarded a two year contract when they didn't perform same criteria that she was required to perform and that there was time when field didn't get mowed for 3 weeks, grass was left lying on the fields. There were time when playing football the grass was 6" tall
- Town got in a jam last year when received the lawn care bids and had to find someone to take care of the lawns and by doing so gave word that they could do for 2 years when they purchased a lawn mower to do the job
- Council don't remember the 2 year lawn care contract, people are getting an impression of Town of Thayne but need to uphold Councilman Heward decision and hope that you will be willing to give the town a bid next year.

Daxton Herd:

- Would like to propose to the council an eagle project to build picnic shelter, has spoken with Councilman Heward and would like to see 3 tables, 4 trees and a grill.
- Would like town to cover expense except for under the tables and will try to get donation for them
