# Thayne Town Council Meeting August 21, 2019 FINAL

### Public Comments

#### **Robert Hood-Sunrise Engineering**

- Thayne Storage Tank Project
  - The lid of the tank has been poured and the remaining work consists of tank interior painting, cleaning disinfection and leakage testing, bring the new tank into service and take the old tank off-line and refurbish.
  - The Town of Thayne has received the third pay request from Western Municipal for a total of \$150,071.30 and the second change order of -\$28,739 for the reduction for steel tank hatch and overflow changes.

### Motion to pay the third pay request to Western Municipal of Wyoming for \$150,071.30

- North Waterline Project
  - The Town of Thayne has received the second pay request for \$85,586.94.
  - The new waterline to the sewer lagoons from Roberts Road is complete along with Moser Ave. waterline. Will bore under Hwy 89 next week and start the tiein at Hemmert.

Motion to pay second pay request to Westwood Curtis Construction for \$85,586.94

- Community Center Parking lot and VanNoy Paving
  - Option of probable cost: Community Center parking lots- \$209,000 VanNoy Reconstruction- \$236,000.
  - Capitol Construction Loan is a 5 year loan at 0.5% interest. Requires a 0.5% origination fee (\$1,000 for a \$200,000 loan). Max loan amount that the Town can borrow is 4% of the Town's assessed value = 0.04 x \$4,760,162 = \$190,406. Application deadline is September 6 for the December SLIB meeting or October 18 for the January SLIB meeting
  - Mineral Royalty Grant is a grant the will cover up to 50% of a project. Application deadline is Sept 19 for the January SLIB meeting.
- Robert Hood also presented the Town Council with a spreadsheet of the costs to chip and seal the remaining roads in the Town of Thayne.

# **Mathew Roberts Building Permit**

- Mayor Simpson asked for comments, concerns and questions regarding the building permit application that was submitted by the Roberts family. Councilman Heward expressed concern of the 10ft easement and stated that if a waterline needs to be repaired or replaced, a 10ft easement will not be enough room to do so. That is why the Town asked for a 20ft easement to begin with.
- The Town Council decided to table the application for one month until more information can be obtained regarding who would be liable if the waterline needs to be replaced or repaired and the foundation needed to be dug up. Mayor Simpson will contact the Roberts family.

# Bruce Dana-Not Present

• Mayor Simpson gave an update of Bruce Dana's concern. Currently both lawns for the Frontier Apartments 4-plex and 6-plex are watered off of the 4-plex water allowance of 120,000 gallons per month and is constantly going over the allowed and paying overages. The water allowance for the 6-plex is 180,000 gallons per month that is not being used. Mr. Dana has requested to combine the two buildings monthly usage due to them being on the same lot. Mayor Simpson asked for questions, comments and a discussion.

# Motion to grant Bruce Dana a variance to combine the water usage of the two Frontier Apartment buildings for the duration of his principal ownership.

- Mayor Simpson asked for thoughts and comments on the paving information that Robert Hood had provided the Town of Thayne with. Councilman Woolley stated that he would like to prioritize the roads and look into chip sealing. Mayor Simpson stated that he is concerned with having new sidewalks installed over at the Community Center without pavement behind. The Town Council decided to apply for the MRG Grant to pave the Community Center parking lots and also apply for the Capital Construction Loan for the paving of VanNoy Parkway.
- Simpson mentioned to the Town Council that he has sat down with Marlow Scherbel and Kevin Voyles to discuss the zoning changes. Mr. Scherbel suggested that instead of changing the zoning of the Town to just grandfather in the properties that are currently not correct. Mayor Simpson stated that this issue can be discussed farther at a later date.
- The Meadows Subdivision is currently working on a new mast plan and the Town of Thayne will start the annexation process. The zoning of the property will be discussed in further workshop meetings.
- Mayor Simpson stated that Elling Wright has asked for a variance to not install curb and gutter in a new subdivision that he would like to build.
- The process for the annexation of the sewer property will be started soon.

- The Thayne Ambulance Service has until September 1<sup>st</sup> 2019 to decide what they would like to do concerning paying the members for calls responded to. Fines shall start September 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Mayor Simpson met with the Senior Center regarding the contract that was submitted. They will meet again in September to discuss further.
- Mayor Simpson asked all of the Councilmembers to make a list of their street priorities so that street maintenance can be started.
