July 20, 2017

Council in attendance: Mayor Lainhart, Councilman Wicks, Councilman Heward, Councilman Woolley, Councilman Schwab and Clerk Hillstead.

Sunrise Engineering:

- Update on Pathway Lighting and Crosswalk Project
 - The project is ready for bid.
 - Robert discussed with the Council solar vs. conventional lighting.
 - With the change of fixtures, the Town was able to decrease the number of lights from ten to seven.
- Water Tank update
 - Robert stated that the budget amendment for the 2017-2018 fiscal year worked and we are just waiting for the go ahead on the loan.
 - Dan property agreement meeting went well, moving forward with the purchase.
- North Waterline Project
 - Robert stated that the Town of Thayne had to redo the environmental process when we moved the line.
 - The designs are complete and we can hopefully get started this year.
- Spring Box Overflows
 - Robert discussed #24 mesh screens vs. flapper valves.

Thayne Fire Department

- Chief Marc Clark introduced the new officers for the Fire Department

Thayne Community Center-Melissa Gable

- Melissa stated that the Community Center has been quiet.
- There is currently a week long art camp happening
- Melissa informed the Council that the Community Center is experiencing camera troubles again. She has had the NVR looked at and they think that the problem is that it

is overheating. Melissa will get a quote on putting a vent in the door to try and provide more air flow.

- There is a home school group that is looking for a place to meet once or twice a month to have larger activities for their children and they are asking for the fees to be waved. The Council felt as though if they are not a nonprofit organization, the Town needs to treat them like the rest of our renters and cannot wave the rental fees.

Thayne Ambulance Service-Lesli Dana

- Lesli reported that there are now four individuals QPR Certified and are able to train valley wide.
- Thayne Ambulance street dance is Saturday July 22.
- There are four EMT Advanced that are going back to school to become Intermediates
- Lesli Dana is now the new Thayne Ambulance Secretary

Maintenance Report- Cliff Eggleston:

- Street update
 - Road patch is on its way
- Update on Emergency Management Coordinator

Mayor Lainhart

- Tap Consultant Selection
 - The Town of Thayne received one statement of interest back out of thirty seven requests; Sunrise Engineering. A Community Committee consisting of Street Commissioner, Concerned Parent, School Principal, Law enforcement and Town Mayor met and discussed the two statements. The committee's suggestion is to award Sunrise Engineering with the Project.
 - The Town Council agreed to award Sunrise Engineering and to direct them to go ahead with the project.
- Caselle

- Mayor Lainhart informed the Council that our current version of Caselle will not be supported after the first of the year and that the Town needs to update. Council agreed to the new cost and approved the update.
- Rustlers
 - Mayor Lainhart has met with Marc and Rusty Andrus twice within the last month, they have two complaints.
 - Marc and Rusty suggested that there are cities that have ordinances to control smoking on public sidewalks. The Mayor stated that as a community we can require that if you are a nonsmoking facility you have to have a designated smoking area within your building. Rustlers claim that Dad's Bar provides a designated area for smoking on the public sidewalk. Dad's Bar and Steakhouse is planning to remodel their building by next spring. Thayne Town Council was in agreement that the Town doesn't want to get involved.
 - Rustler's second complaint was about the bands playing at Dad's Bar. Rusty and Marc state that the bands play too long and are too loud, their renters are complaining. Mayor Lainhart stated that he feels as though that is a commercial zone and the Town doesn't have a noise ordinance therefor the Town of Thayne isn't going to restrict commercial entities. The Council agreed and Mayor Lainhart will inform Rustlers of the Council's decisions.
- Mayor Lainhart informed the Council that he has met with the Wyoming Business Council. June 30, 2017 was the closing date for the Thayne Business Ready Grant. The project is still incomplete due to the unreleased easements. Mayor Lainhart asked for an extension for the project and also presented the sewer connections requested by Kip Wilkes and Silver Star, the future paving of Hokanson Ave and submitted all costs for replacing the Hokanson Ave Bridge for reimbursement. The Town is now waiting for a reply from the Wyoming Business Council.
- Mayor Lainhart announced that Rachelle Hyde is now the new Assistant Clerk and that she will also be cleaning the Town Hall.

- Ash Muir is unable to do tackle and flag football, Councilman Heward is currently looking for someone to be in charge of those sports.
