Mid-Valley Fire District Contract-Lance Skinner

The contract will start on July 10, 2022 to make sure the Fire Department is covered by the Town's insurance for the July 4th Celebration.

Wagner Sewer Variance (Downing Subdivision)

No Variance was filed. The owner, Kaycee Wagner, called into the meeting and expressed concern about the cost and the difficulty of being on grade to bore under the Thayne-Bedford Road to hook onto the Town sewer and that the County had denied their request to trench across Thayne-Bedford Road. They asked the council about the possibility for them to receive a variance to have a septic tank on their property. The council believes it is in the

best interest of the Town to have them and others that build in the town hook onto the system and will work with them to find a way to do so.
